OVERVIEW

We are pleased to announce that the Maintenance Science Summer School will be held this summer. The event is organized by the Japan Society of Maintenology (both by the head office and the Tohoku and Hokkaido Chapter), Tohoku University Global COE Program “World Center of Education and Research for Trans-disciplinary Flow Dynamics” (the GCOE) and Tohoku University.

The summer school aims at providing participants with the opportunity to learn practice and theory for the maintenance activities of nuclear power plants. It also intends to the friendship exchange of students and young researchers in Asian countries. We expect participations of graduate students especially who eager to learn the maintenance activity from academic point of view, and contribute to the enhancement of maintenance of nuclear power plants in a future.
